Reflections from our Director

During February, National Black History Month, we celebrate the achievements and legacy of Black Americans as an integral part of our shared American history. One of Bread of Life's Core Values is to "Build community by incorporating individuals and groups that represent the diversity of our cities as volunteers, partner organizations, board members and staff." At Bread of Life, we not only welcome diversity, we need it.



When we think of how we differ from each other, there are truly a lot of factors: race, culture, ethnicity, primary language, religion, gender, economic class, political views, urban/rural, occupation, interests, skills, communication styles.... It sometimes amazes me that we can understand each other and get along at all! That's one reason why we need to tap the rich diversity of people in our communities to be part of our work at every level – volunteers, staff, board and donors. Each person brings to the work of Bread of Life a unique combination of experience, understanding, knowledge and skills shaped by these many factors. This helps Bread of Life to build community and better serve those in need. A few of the hundreds of people who are part of Bread of Life's work come to my mind:

An African American woman who manages our Everett Mobile Market, coordinates volunteers, and does our main food pickups

A South African father who works at our evening meals program and is parenting a child with special needs

A Cantonese-speaking Federal employee who volunteers to provide interpreting services at our Malden food pantry

A Mexican-American woman who works as a laborer in the construction industry and volunteers to clean in our Malden food pantry

An Arab-American healthcare worker and mom who organizes product at our food warehouse

Bread of Life needs diversity, equitable access, and inclusion of multiple perspectives at all levels of our organization in order to be successful in our work for food equity, food justice and, ultimately, food security for all. Thank you for partnering with us in this empowering work, and for helping make hunger history.

Under One Roof Update

During February, our contractor continues work on the foundation at [54 Eastern Ave, Malden](#). When our facility is completed, estimated to be January 2024, we will have two floors of space for Bread of Life programs and administration, giving us increased capacity to receive and store food donations, increased scheduling latitude for food distribution, and increased ability to utilize volunteers. Our housing partner, Metro North Housing Corp, will own and operate 14 permanent, rent-subsidized studio apartments on the third floor for local homeless individuals and veterans who will be able to access Bread of Life programs within the facility.

Bread of Life utilizes hundreds of volunteers and dozens of partner organizations to distribute food through our primary programs: food pantries; prepared and congregate meals; grocery delivery to senior citizens; nutrition backpack distribution to at-risk Everett public school youth; food delivery to homeless individuals and families in shelter; and Food Access project to overcome barriers to accessing nutritious food encountered by lower-income communities with respect to race, ethnicity, language, culture, age, gender and other factors.
